ABOUT THIS POSITION

• Counselors and Respite workers are responsible for assisting campers to whatever degree necessary while attending Camp Red Leaf, including those of daily living, if needed (showering, dressing, bathing, eating, etc.). Some of our campers require one-on-one care including personal care (changing clothes, aid in the shower, changing diapers/helping use the bathroom, feeding/cutting food, helping campers get involved/participate in activities such as (arts and crafts, sports, dancing, games, etc.) and cultivating relationships. Many of our campers are fully capable of their own personal care and are in cabin groups of about 8 other campers with 3-5 counselors working together. Staff are also responsible for all campers' belongings. Most importantly, the counselor is responsible for the supervision, care and safety of the campers while being a supportive and positive role model.
